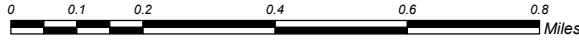


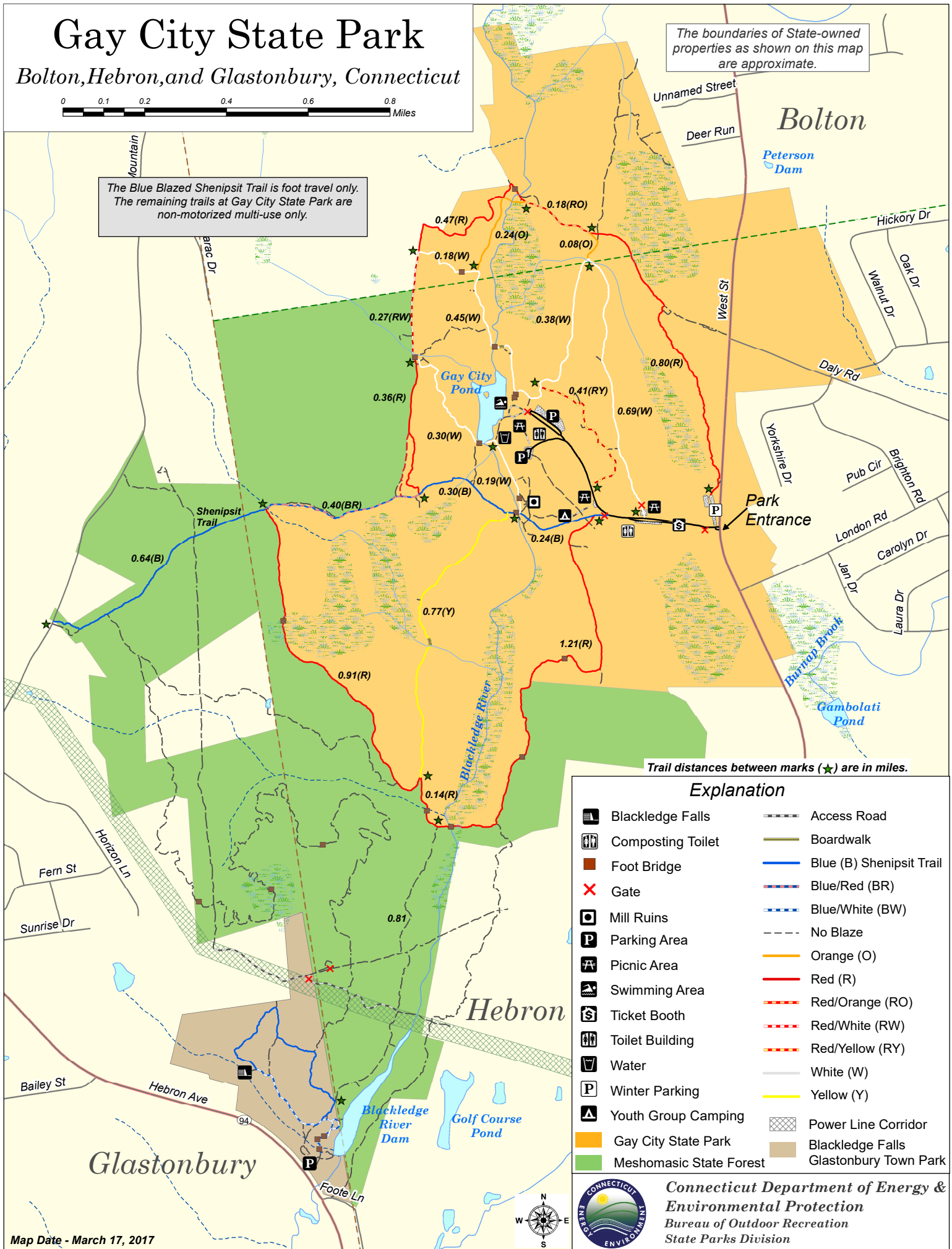
Gay City State Park
