CULVERT WORK WILL CLOSE MAIN PARK ENTRANCE ROAD FOR THE WEEK OF MAY 5TH – MAY 9TH, 2025



## INFORMATION REGARDING CONSTRUCTION PLAN AND DETOUR ROUTE FOR VEHICLE AND PEDESTRIAN TRAVEL

Construction work will be completed by a DEEP sub-contractor (Precision Trenchless, LLC) and is expected to take approximately 3 – 5 days to complete between Monday, May 5th and Friday, May 9th. The main entrance/exit road will be closed to traffic between the ticket booth and the rotary during this time. The project will consist of lining a 60" culvert pipe to help reinforce the culvert to prepare for a future paving project. The project has received permitting that will allow for de-watering activities on both sides of the road to complete this work and therefore will require a road closure during this time.

Beginning Monday, May 5 at 7:00 a.m., the flow of visitor traffic entering and exiting the park will be re-routed through the campground entrance. Additional information and a map showing the detour route is available by visiting ctparks.com, and searching Hammonasset Beach State Park.
